

Disappearing Glass Fish

Some clear things can bend light more than other clear things.




That is why we can see the clear glass fish in the clear air! Glass, air, and water each bend light in different amounts. They have different index of refraction (n).



You can still see the fish in water!

But glass and glycerin have the same index of refraction so...



The fish is there but you can't see it!
